Resources for Preparing for the CSET and CBEST

- 1. Complete the sample tests from <u>CSET website</u>.
- 2. **Give yourself plenty of time** to prepare, and allow time to retake tests
 - a. Look up result release dates to plan when to take tests
 - b. Be aware that you need to wait 45 days before retaking an exam
- 3. Use a study book: There are many different options, here are some recommendations:
 - a. Check out study guides from the public library or buy used copies online
 - b. Kaplan Study Book
 - c. Cliff Notes study book
- 4. Watch YouTube tutorials based on your authorization and exam
- 5. Specifically for the **social science** CSET.
 - a. Focus studies on economics, California history, and world religions
 - b. Be sure to review California, African, and Asian History
 - c. A 7th grade world history book has most of the information to know about non-western history
- 6. Specifically for math and science CSET preparation
 - a. The Fresno State Math and Science Initiative provides free online workshops designed to help you prepare for the math and science CSETs

PROS of CSET Single Session	CONS of CSET Single Session
 Save \$50 (\$250 vs. \$300) Finish it all in one sitting in 5 hours Get all subtest results at once 	 Time crunch (5 hrs. vs. 8 hrs.) May have to drive out farther because not a lot of locations do the 5 hr. session; more locations have single subtests available Have to schedule in advance (like maybe 1-2 months ahead depending on which location you want to go to); but can schedule single subtest last minute (at least 24 hrs.) because more locations offer it Butt will hurt for sitting so long (but they give you a 15 min break)

Retake Policy

A test or subtest may be taken as many times as necessary to achieve a passing score.

A passing score must be achieved at a single test administration. Performance on parts of a test or subtest cannot be combined across administrations. If you wish to retake a test or subtest, you must re-register for the entire test or subtest.

You must wait 45 calendar days from the date you took the test to retake a test or subtest on computer. If you have registered to take more than one subtest comprising a single test in a single testing session, you must wait 45 calendar days from the date of your test appointment to retake any of the subtests for which you registered, even if you did not attempt or complete all subtests for which you were registered.
